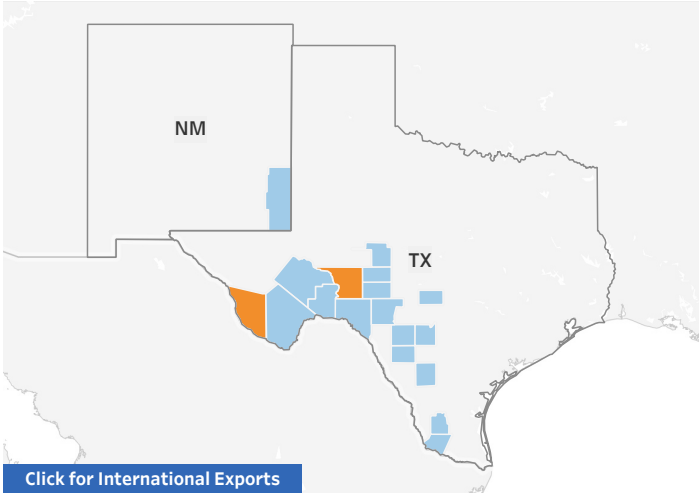

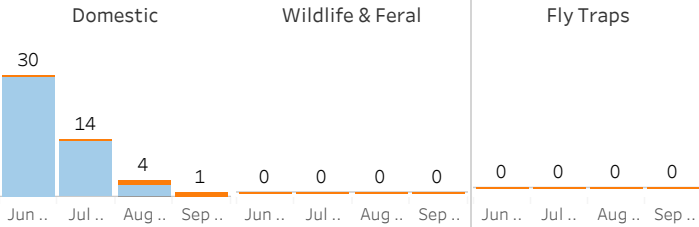


Table of Cases
